We accomplish this by offering pregnancy testing, limited ultrasounds, prenatal education, pregnancy options coaching, parenting earn-while-you-learn classes, and post-abortion recovery support all free of charge.

8 PROJECTS YOU HELPED INITIATE IN 2024



Growth in Medical Services and Decision Support Services

Pregnancy testing and decision support increased by 16%. Ultrasound services grew by 21.5%. This increase is due to offering walk-in pregnancy testing and 2 additional nurses trained in ultrasound.







Hispanic Support/Services

91% increase in individuals served who identify as Hispanic. Spanish speaking Advocate on site to offer decision support in their native language and translate for nurse consultations and ultrasound.



SEEN: A Birth Mother Support Program

Advocacy staff began offering this program to post-adoption birth mothers in effort to support them emotionally and spiritually in their choice of adoption for their baby.







Increase in Material Goods Assistance

Doubled appointments monthly for baby goods distribution.

Girlology Program

Medical education program led by staff nurses geared toward girls 8-18. Curriculum teaches students about their reproductive systems, puberty, relationships and more from a biblical perspective.



H.E.A.R.D. Medical Services

Pregnancy testing began at PRC in Heard County bringing needed medical services to that community.







Revamp of Fall Fundraising Dinner

Development Department worked on revamping this fundraising event in an effort to raise more funds and establish this event as the "Premiere Pro-Life Event in West Georgia"



Fatherhood Mentorship Program

Groundwork was laid for the initiation of this program in January 2025. Five men were approved as Fatherhood Mentor volunteers.

One-on-one mentoring sessions will be conducted through the Parenting Plus program.






Where the income came from

CHALLENGES FACED IN 2024 & IMPROVEMENTS IN 2025

Challenge 1: Unsustainable & Inconsistent Funding

Without sustainable and consistent income, PRC will be unable to strategically plan for the further development of programs, services and support channels in an effort to help save the preborn babies.

How We'll Improve: Diversify Funding Sources

PRC's board of directors, executive leadership and development team will create additional funding sources through the following strategies: planned/legacy giving, major partner cultivation, and promotion of PRC's Heroes for Life Monthly Giving Program.

Challenge 2: Vulnerable Information Technology and Security

In an ever-increasing hostile environment toward pro-life ministries, PRC's virtual footprint is vulnerable to attack including HIPAA weaknesses, hackers, and other sinister attacks.

How We'll Improve: Bolster Information Technology Security

Utilize cyber security insurance coverage and bolster information security measures through cyber security and cloud management, remote information backup and management and email migration.

Challenge 3: Outgrowing Carrollton Facility

PRC services at the Carrollton center are close to outgrowing the current building. To have physical square footage to grow, a larger building will be needed in the next 3-5 years.

How We'll Improve: Monitor Situation & Plan For New Facility

Continue to monitor levels of patient and client "traffic" watching for thresholds which will be a clue to the need for moving to a larger facility. Also, the Board of Directors will continue to monitor cash flow and financial bandwidth to support a move of this size.
